

**** Windows XP – most brands of Wireless Card ****

Centrino™ (or other inbuilt wireless card) users

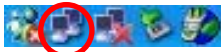
You may need to turn on your inbuilt wireless LAN card, especially if you have not used it before. This is typically done using a switch located on the side or bottom of your laptop, or you may need to try a softkey combination. Consult your laptop manual for details. Then go to **step 2**.

1. Insert a wireless 802.11b/g card* into your laptop

Wait approximately 10 seconds while Windows XP loads the drivers for your wireless card and detects the presence of any wireless networks.

2. Select to join the Azure network

A networking icon will appear in the System Tray



and a text bubble should appear on your screen.

If the text bubble says, “Wireless Network Connection... Connected to: Azure” then proceed to **step 4**.

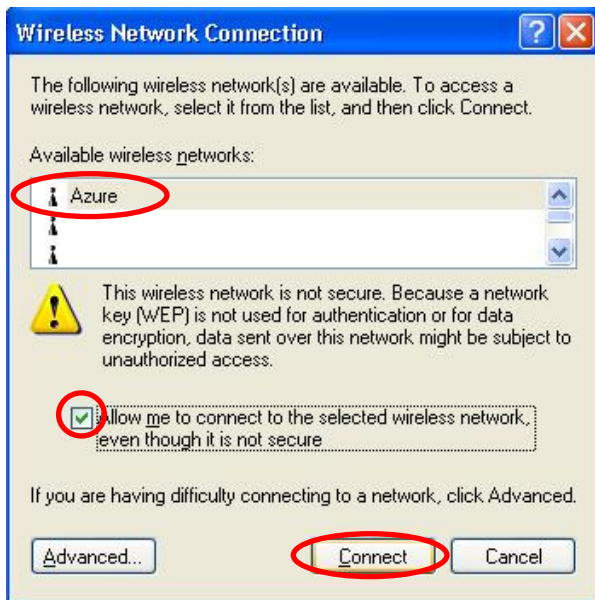
If the text bubble says, “Windows has detected several wireless networks...” then click on the bubble or network icon and proceed to **step 3**.

If no text bubble appears, then right-click on the network icon and click “View Available Wireless Networks”.

3. Select the Azure network

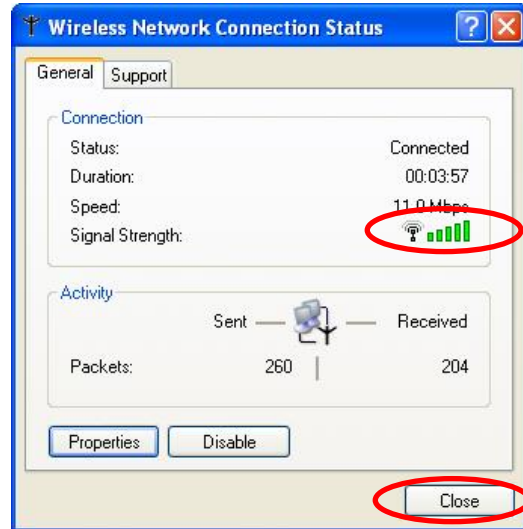
The window below will appear. Select “Azure”, tick the box as shown, and then click Connect.

(Note: tick box may not be shown with all Win XP versions)



4. Confirm connection and signal strength

Open the **Wireless Networking** window (shown below) by clicking on the network icon in the System Tray.



If the signal indicator has less than 2 bars, then you might consider relocating yourself to get a better signal.

5. Open your web browser

Open any valid web page, and within a few seconds the Azure network will send you a login screen. Follow the onscreen login process to select your preferred billing option (through your ISP, via credit card, or by using a pre-paid card) and complete the login process.

6. Once you have finished the login process, you can browse the Internet, use your email, or launch a Virtual Private Network (or other secure encrypted connection) to your corporate network. **To logoff**, disconnect any VPNs and then click the Logout button.

* These cards are the standard wireless cards used in most home/office wireless LAN's. Wireless cards can be purchased from any computer retailer/vendor.
